The Hall is approximately a 10 minute walk from Roma Street Station/Busway.

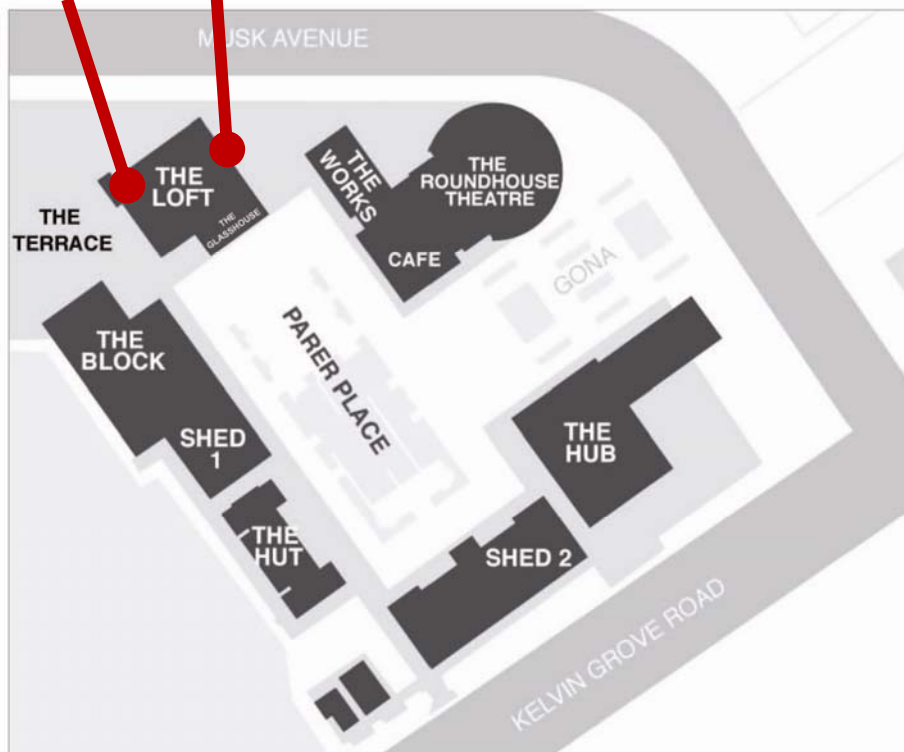
Car parking
